Health insurance	EU/EEA students need to have an EU health Insurance Card non-EU students need to have a health insurance before arrival (it is also needed for the residence permit)
Visa and residence permit	EU/EEA students do not need visas to enter Hungary, but in case of staying longer than 90 days, they will be required to register their places of residence. Non-EU students should apply for a residence permit for study purposes / purpose of student exchange at the nearest Hungarian Embassy/Consulate. Residence permit cards of are posted to the host university by the Hungarian immigration office and can be requested from the International Center of DGU upon arrival.
